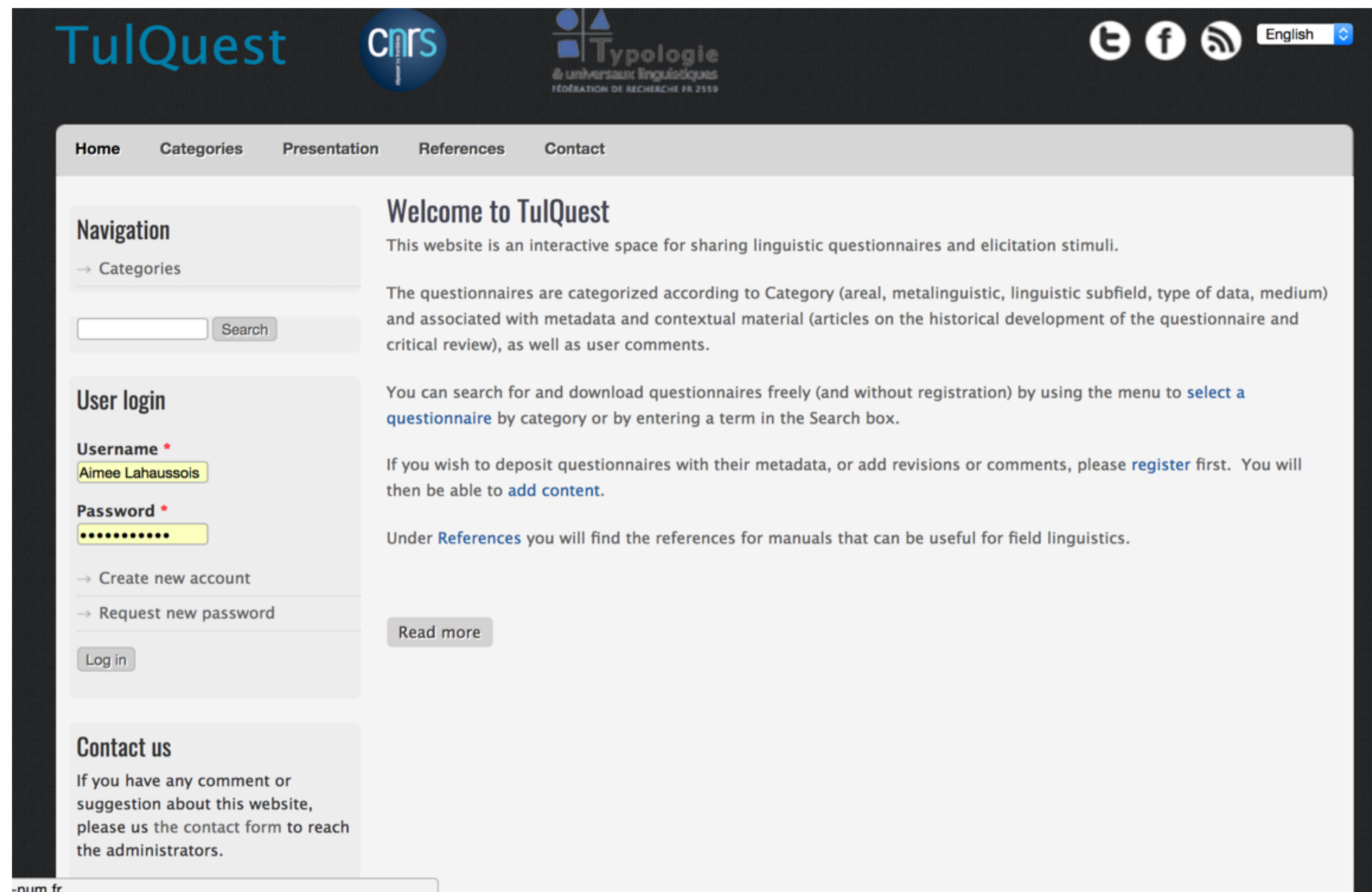




TULQuest: an interactive archive for linguistic Questionnaires

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Definition of object of study: Questionnaire (with a capital "Q") as cover term for any methodological tool designed to collect linguistic data. Covers visual stimuli, word lists, written questionnaires, descriptive templates, checklists, etc.

Practical details

Perceived need for an interactive archive for linguistic tools for data collection/comparison.
Free access and download of materials. Registration only necessary when adding new content.
List of useful references on fieldwork.
Archive is English-French bilingual in interface.

Two actions possible:

Search for a Questionnaire & Add new content
(requires registration on website)

Searching
Based on taxonomy of Questionnaires, under categories.
Also possible to search through text box.
Leads to a Questionnaire file.

Goals

"This questionnaire explicates the different aspects of negation that should be covered in the description of the domain of negation in a language. The questionnaire itself does not explain very deeply the typology of the different subdomains of negation of give examples. The questionnaire meant to be used together with typological literature (e.g. Miestamo 2007, in press)." (Miestamo, 2016: 1)

Protocol summary

"The questionnaire starts from function and asks what the formal constructions expressing these functions are in each language". (Miestamo, 2016: 1)

It is divided in four parts, themselves divided into sections :

1. The language (basically, the metadata).
2. The clausal negation.
3. The non-clausal negation.
4. Other aspects of negation (such as the scope of negation or the negative polarity).

Development context

This is a revised version of the negation questionnaire originally published in Miestamo et al. 2015. (Miestamo, Matti, Anne Tamm & Beáta Wagner-Nagy. 2015. Negation in Uralic languages. Typological Studies in Language 108. Amsterdam: Benjamins.)
